- Assist in monitoring program schedule to ensure that programming is accurately recorded;
- Performing and assembling basic research in support of programs;
- Writing and preparing simple scripts;
- Auditing and timing segments of programs noting necessary information and ensuring appropriate revisions have been made;
- Performing simple, routine, and obvious edits;
- Perform other duties as assigned by the Department Head.
